Ride Smart

- Know the laws
- Stay off lakes until they are staked
- Don't go around barriers or fences
- Travel on marked trails only
- Don't cut corners
- Sawyer County speed limit is **55 MPH** after dark

Follow the laws and avoid the Fines!

Approximate costs of fines:

Trespassing	\$263.50
Operate Without Trail Sticker.....	\$200.50
DWI.....	\$641.50
Over 55 mph at night.....	\$389.50
Failure to Keep Right.....	\$200.50
Highway & Roadway Violations.....	\$200.50

HAYWARD SNO-MADS SNOWMOBILE CLUB Established 1961

Hayward Sno-Mads is one of the oldest snowmobile clubs in Wisconsin. We are one of 10 snowmobile and ATV clubs that form the Sawyer County Snowmobile & ATV Alliance. The Alliance, though independent from the County, works with all government agencies for the sole purpose of developing and maintaining motorized recreation trails.

There are about 600 miles of trails within the County and several of these connect with the trails of surrounding counties. With the exception of the Tuscobia and Flambeau River State Forest trails, snowmobile clubs built all of the snowmobile trails in the County. Alliance members operate 14 tractors to give you the best trails in the State of Wisconsin. Trail funding comes from several sources but it's never enough and does not include the labor that is provided by clubs. ***The DNR does not maintain our trails! Volunteers do all of the work***

What do Sno-Mads Do?

Sno-Mads is a family centered club with some support from local businesses. Volunteers donate their time and equipment to prepare, sign, brush, and groom safe trails for public use. Sno-Mads maintains about 125 miles of trails in Sawyer County, mostly north of the city of Hayward, and north of Hwy. 77.

Discounted Trail Passes

By Joining the Hayward Sno-Mads Snowmobile Club and the AWSC (Association of Wisconsin Snowmobile Clubs) and having a snowmobile registered in the state of Wisconsin you are eligible for a discounted trail pass for only \$10.00 per sled. Purchase trail passes on the AWSC website or in person at their office.

We're serious about safety!

In addition to providing safe trails we provide instructors who teach the DNR Snowmobile Safety Course, which is required for all riders born after 1984.

Sno-Mad Members Have Fun!!

We ride on daylong trips every Wednesday throughout the season, leaving from Hayward Power Sports at 10:00 AM. We socialize, have cookouts, raise money for scholarships, and participate in community events.
